Troop SAVE-A- SPOT Campsite Deposit	\$100	One-time fee per Unit to SAVE-A-SPOT
Early Bird Fee <i>Before May 1</i>	\$525	If the balance is paid in full by May 1, 2024 , the fee will be \$525
Regular Camp Fee	\$560	Paid after May 1, 2024
Webelos / AOL Crossovers	\$525	These Scouts are always afforded the lowest possible camp fee rate.
New Scout Fee	\$525	For Scouts who join the troop as new Scouts between May and the beginning of the troop's week at camp.
National Youth Leadership Training	\$400	Second week discount does not apply.
Councilor in Training	\$200	One-time fee, May be selected to return at no additional charge.

Encore or 2 nd Week Camper Fee	\$375	The registration process will require identifying the Scout's other camp/week. To qualify, a scout must have <u>already</u> <u>spent a week</u> in a BSA Scout Camp (Any Council), NOAC , or National BSA High Adventure Base , and the discount applies to a second (or more) week at one of the CRC's camps, <u>AFTER</u> the other program/camp.
Sibling Discount (Per Child)	\$25	A \$25 discount will be given to help those families with siblings attending Resident Camp. The \$50 discount will be applied to the second Scout in BlackPug.

Adult Leader Fees:

Two Adult Leaders	FREE	Two adults are required for minimum supervision per Youth Protection Guidelines. Additional FREE Leaders per the chart. Names of leaders are not required until May.
Additional Unit Leaders (Week)	\$150	Leader Fee (<mark>by the</mark> <mark>Week</mark>)
Additional Unit Leaders (Day)	\$25	Leader Fee (<mark>By the</mark> <mark>Day</mark>)

Camperships:

The Connecticut Rivers Council will continue to award camperships to assist Scouts who need funds to attend camp and might not otherwise do so. The annual campership fund is limited and fluctuates from year to year. Like Webelos crossovers and new Scouts, campership Scouts will also be afforded the lowest possible rate to attend camp. Those asking for Camperships should be named, and a \$50 deposit should be submitted by March 15 in BlackPug.

Refund Policy:

The Connecticut Rivers Council must commit financial resources to purchase equipment, hire staff, and otherwise prepare to provide the high-quality programs in our camps well in advance of the camps opening for the summer. Participants therefore must be prepared to make a financial commitment to attend. Refund requests made before June 15th will be reimbursed the fee minus the cancellation fee of \$75. Requests after June 15th will be reimbursed the fee minus the cancellation fee of \$150. In the event of an illness we will process a refund if you cannot attend camp. If a camp attendee presents signs of illness while at camp, we reserve the right to send them home without a refund.

NOTE: This year has been a difficult year to establish camp fees. We have had to anticipate increases in food, electricity, fuel, every type of insurance, and camp staff payrolls. Through the budgeting process we anticipated raising camp fees \$50.00 per Scout. Working with The Peter & Carmen Lucia Buck Foundation, they agreed to generously underwrite the 2024 camp fee increase by subsidizing each Scout attending summer camp by \$50.00.
