## Procedure for Female or Linked Units

J.N. Webster is a Scout Reservation that welcomes both Male and Female Scouts.

There must be a registered female adult leader 21 years of age or over in every unit serving females. A registered female adult leader 21 years of age or over must be present for any activity involving female youth. Notwithstanding the minimum leader requirements, age- and program-appropriate supervision must always be provided. The Scoutmaster of the Female unit need not be a Female.

There are two ways that a Female Scouts BSA Troop can attend JNW.

The first would be as a seperate Troop attending in their own campsite alone or shared with another Female Troop. This female troop would operate just as any Troop would that is staying at JNW.

The second would be as a linked Troop sharing a campsite with their Male counterpart. A letter is needed from the Chartered Organization acknowledging that the two units will be sharing the campsite. Parents from both troops should be made aware that the site will be occupied by both Male and Female scouts but with obvious separate accommodations. Each Linked troop must maintain their own individual identity during their week at camp. Linked units will be seated together in the dining hall.

Provisional Leadership and accommodations are provided by the Camp Staff all Season in out THUNDERBIRDS program.
